Scientific Research Ethics Committee



There are three models:


- 1. Exemption form from ethical review (for the College of Pharmacy)
- 2. Animal model (approved by Prof. Dr. Mai Helmy, then Prof. Maha Ghanem)
- 3. Complete non-medical or medical ethical review form (Faculty of Medicine)
- In the case of research elicited from a thesis (a previous ethical review was taken) and the title of the research does not match the title of the thesis, a modification of the title of the research (Attachment 5) is submitted and the same approval number for the thesis is obtained through the office of the Vice Dean for Graduate Studies accredited.
- A monthly report on all committee applicants is sent to the university.


Number of Egyptian students enrolled in diplomas and Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) for the academic year 2022-2023




Number of Egyptian students enrolled in master degree in pharmaceutical sciences for the academic year 2022-2023

Number of foreign students enrolled in postgraduate programs For the academic year 2022-2023




Number of Egyptian students awarded diplomas in the academic year 2022-2023










Number of researches published in indexed international journals for the academic year 2022-2023

• 34 books were purchased based on recommendations from the different scientific departments with a total cost of 63241.70 L.E






Scientific missions from 1/6/2022 to 31/7/2023




Numbers of faculty members who attended conferences and meetings from 1/7/2022 until now
