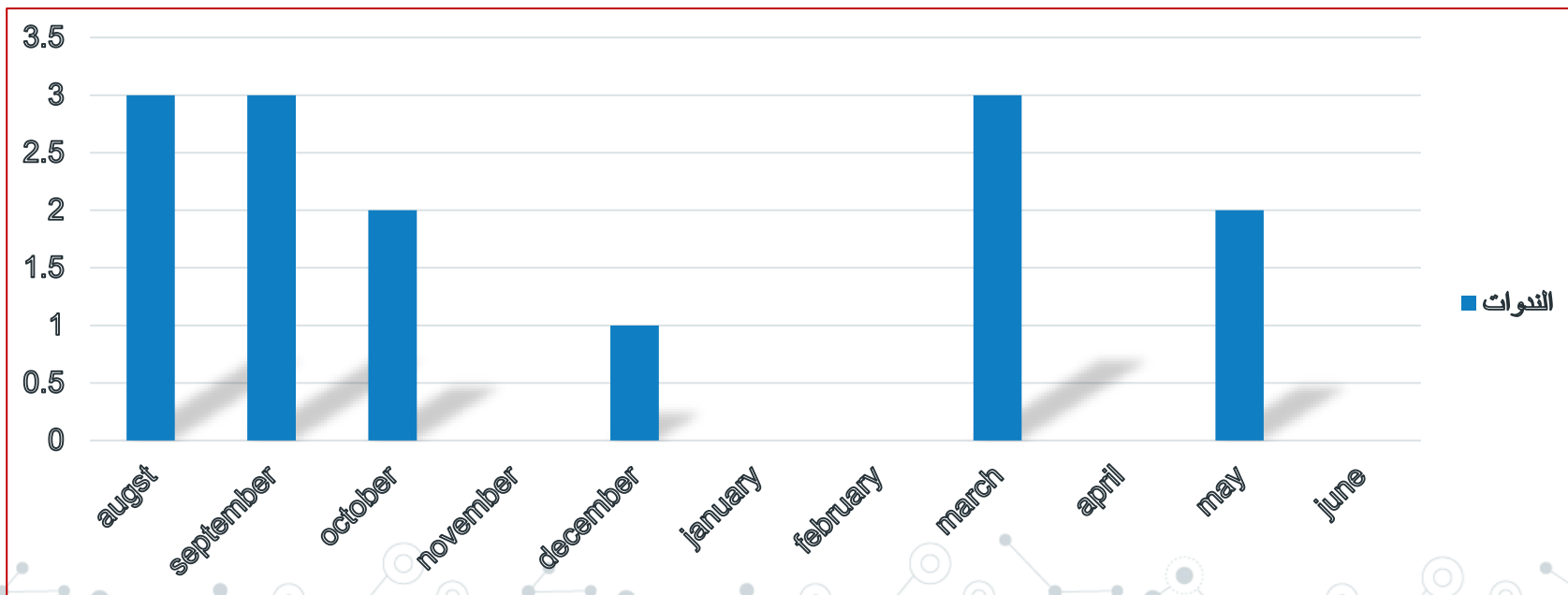

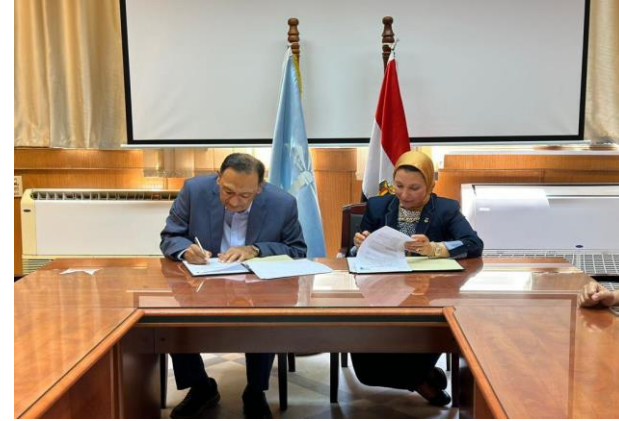

Organizing the College World Conference PHS 2022

Hilton Green Plaza Wednesday and Thursday 23rd & 24th November 2022



- ❑ The conference was opened under the patronage and presence of, **Dr. Abdel Aziz Konsouh President of Alexandria University** and **Dr. Yasser Refaat, Deputy Minister of Higher Education for Scientific Research Affairs.**
- ❑ The conference was attended by the **Egyptian Drug Authority**, where the conference adopted **Egypt's Vision for Healthcare 2030.**
- ❑ The conference during its current session hosted:
 - Nearly 60 pharmaceutical and medical sciences from various Egyptian and international universities
 - **More** than 1000 participants from Egypt and around the world
 - **18 sessions** were held containing **53 scientific lectures**, dialogues and workshops, delivered by **21 scientists from international universities** and **32 Egyptian scientists**
 - The conference included a presentation of **118 posters**, over two days
 - The presence of 20 Egyptian and international medical institutions and companies in the field of manufacturing and marketing medicines, equipment and public pharmacies
- ❑ The opening proceedings included honoring a number of pioneers and professors of the Faculty of Pharmacy, Alexandria University.



Report on the achievements of the Occupational Safety and Health Department

During 2022-2023

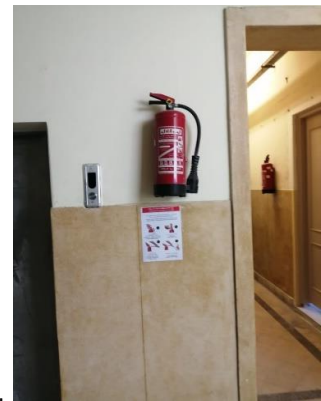


Training Profile:

A training course (theoretical and practical) was held at the college on "**Fire and Rescue**" to train and raise the efficiency of 110 college employees to deal with types of fires and risks within the various workplaces in the college.



A course was held at the college on "**Safety and Civil Health**" on securing the work environment and facing crises and disasters. Department members attended a training course on "**First Aid**" at the College of Nursing.



File dealing with the "Civil Protection Department"

A. Handling fire extinguishers

- Approving the evacuation and emergency plan and training the college staff on the fire systems from the Civil Protection Department.
- Making a comprehensive inventory of all fire extinguishers in the college in cooperation with the Civil Protection Department to renew the validity of extinguishers.
- Making a comprehensive inventory of all fire boxes based on the inspection report from the Civil Protection
- Signs have been completed to raise awareness of how to use extinguishers in a safe manner and placed next to each extinguisher.
- Sending requests to the Civil Protection Department regarding the renewal of the license of fire extinguishers in the college and maintenance work for damaged devices.
- Sending requests to the Civil Protection Department regarding the training of the prescribed percentage of the facility's employees on firefighting work.

B. Alarm Networks

- Based on the reports of the "Civil Protection Department", it became clear that the alarm and fire network in the faculty is completely dilapidated and must be worked on
- On changing them and adjusting their drainage networks and adjusting the diameter of the hoses from 2.5 inches to 4 inches.
- Due to the high cost, the college hired the university administration to conduct a tender to renew the alarm and fire network
- The Safety Department has sent correspondence to companies specialized in this field, and the companies have already visited the college and made full reports on the safety of the network and made quotations for renewal and work is underway in the tender through the university administration.

Hazardous Waste Disposal File

Solid and liquid waste:

The contract with the "Hazardous Waste Management" in Nasiriyah in Borg El Arab was renewed on 4/3/2023 as follows:

- Liquid or solid chemicals weighing 2000 kg
- Expired medicines weighing 1000 kg
- Fluorescent bulbs weighing 40 kg

Biological waste:

Biological waste (experimental animals and agar dishes) is disposed of in coordination with the Infection Control Unit of the Faculty of Medicine.





First aid file

- All old first aid supplies, including medicines, disinfectants, special supplies for wounds, burns, painkillers and drops, have been replaced in all departments of the scientific and administrative college, and replaced with new contents, with the thankful support of the Medical Professions Company and donations.
- The department follows up the expiry dates and missing quantities of medicines in the college's first aid boxes.

Health Insurance File

- The contract with the health insurance clinic Muhammad Farid in Muharram Bey is renewed in May of each year.
- A list of the names of laboratory workers and contacts of chemicals of all kinds is prepared to make an early detection and send it to the contracting party.
- The clinic conducts medical analyzes and rumors for workers to ensure that they are free of diseases.

File of monthly and semi-annual periodic reports

- The contingency plan has been approved by the Manpower Office.
- A monthly meeting is held for the members of the "Civil Safety and Health" Committee to discuss all developments in the college and prepare the monthly reports required by the "Office of Occupational Safety and Health" to make a monthly record in this regard.
- The Department of Occupational Safety and Health submits a semi-annual report to the "Office of Occupational Safety in Smouha" in order to determine the cases of injuries in the college (if any) and a statement of the number of actual working hours and sick leaves.

Infrastructure maintenance work file in coordination with the workshop

- Obtaining a certificate from the water company stating the diameter of the water source with periodic maintenance by the company.
- Changing a broken drain pipe in the Pharmaceutical Research Complex.
- Follow up the condition of the bathrooms throughout the school year and during exams.
- Applications have been submitted to Prof. Dr. Walid Abdel Azim - Vice Dean of the Faculty of Engineering for Community Service and Environmental Development, regarding the follow-up:
- Alarms in the college, as the existing is dilapidated based on the companies' report during the inspection
- The presence of cracks in the fourth floor beam in the administrative building
- Automatic Fire Extinguishing Network Renewal
- The process of restoring the sixth floor of the old building and the ninth floor of the new building.

- Maintenance of the surface in the administrative building to treat water leakage on the Youth Care Department.





- Making tamping and tiling from the inside of the floor of two computer patches on the ground floor of the new building to eliminate unpleasant odors emanating from the floor.



- Water pipes were welded above the student imaging unit and on the front and back sides of the old building using an external rope ladder.
